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
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I. System Requirement

One of the most important problems the user should pay more attention is the user's running environment. The software was developed by Microsoft Visual C++ 2008 which base on the .Net Framework 3.5 SP1. Every computer which wants to run this software should have this environment.

II. Install


After the use click Setup icon, if the computer didn't have it, the (Fig.1) will show on the screen. If the user accepts the requirement of the agreement, the software will download the .Net Framework automatically. If the user doesn't want to download the .Net Framework 3.5 SP1, just click the Don't Accept.









After the user click Close, the user could use the software by click the icon which is on the desktop or the icon in the start menu.


III.Simple Start



The open file dialog will be shown. User can Select any .cpp or txt file as source file.





The Result matched C++ File will be shown in the right text box.






After that, the user can run this source file or copy it into their project to run it.

IV. Functions Description


1. How to Open Files

There are two ways to open a file in this software. One way is \P [Open Occam Source File] (Fig.13). The other way is click the button () which is in the top of the left text area. After the click, the open dialog will be opened. The user could open a file to left text area (Fig.14). In the same way, the user also could open a file to right text area. After the user click translate button, it will show to

the user in the text area.




2. Translate Source Code

There are two ways to Translate Source Code to C++ Source Code. However, the translating function can not be used, if the user did not open the source file in the (Fig.15). 
code.







3. View


The user could select which quick button (Start, Save, Open) will show on the main Frame by View menu. (Fig 17)

4. Save File




5. Export File
